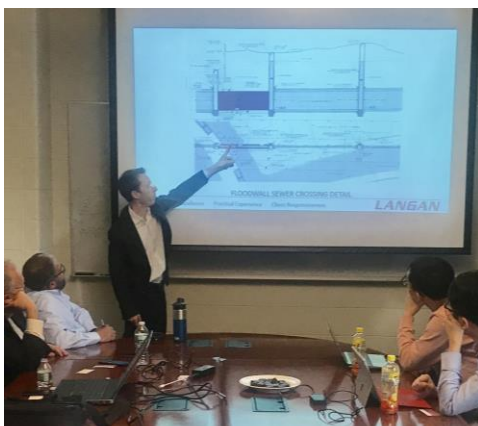

CBIPS Fellows from the 2018-2019 inaugural year participated in a series of hour-long Housing Lectures on campus in the CBIPS Studio Lab or the Department Conference Room. Experts in housing design and construction were invited to discuss their affordable housing work, with a focus on current projects at the New York City Housing Authority (NYCHA). The series was inaugurated by George Leventis and Kelly Tuffs of Langan, who spoke about their post-Sandy site engineering work at NYCHA's Baruch Houses on the Lower East Side. The series also included discussion about NYCHA's design standards and NextGen NYCHA program by Bruce Eisenberg, deputy director of NYCHA's Office of Design.
