Students were accompanied by CBIPS faculty and hosted by the project engineer, responsible architect, or the client. Site visits complemented ongoing research by CBIPS Fellows. A group of 2018-19 Fellows doing research on public-private partnerships was able to learn about project development with Lissa So, a partner at Marvel Architects, about her work on St. Ann's Warehouse at Brooklyn Bridge Park. Fellows interested in modular construction spoke on site at the Brooklyn Post-Disaster Emergency Housing prototype with both James Garrison, the project architect, and James McConnell, of NYC Emergency Management. Site visits emphasized sustainability and resiliency as applied to the intersection of building design, infrastructure systems, and public space.
